High school art teacher Nancy Coon nurtured her talented student's intrinsic imaginative impetus. "Mrs. Coon was gung-ho into '60s happenings," reminisces Cavin. "She took our class to The Metropolitan Museum of Art and let us loose to explore New York galleries. She encouraged me

to take chances in art. Naturally, I tried everything. Things were so exciting; so much happened that changed everything. It was a big crazy time."

After, two weeks at sleepy Muskingum College in New Concord, Ohio, Cavin sought the guidance of her mentor.

Coon encouraged her to enroll at North Illinois University where her own guru Dr. Arends was head of the art school. "My father was adamant that the purpose of col-



lege/art school was to be able to make a living. It wasn't to learn how to paint portraits or throw pottery, which I would have preferred. Consequently, I went into graphic design and earned a B.A. in visual communications – BC, before computers.”

Cavin's skills stood out in a New Jersey flexo printing plate company and as the art director at The Printshop in Wayne after she and her husband Bruce moved to West Chester. When the first of her two daughters was born, she established a successful freelance graphic arts business at her home studio.

“After 30 years, I realized I wasn't having fun anymore. I closed my studio the end of 2003 and floundered about a bit,” says Cavin. “Then a friend and I introduced North American art and craft at an Oakbourne Mansion show. We called it The 5 Senses because we consciously presented all five senses. After the partnership ended, I wasn't sure what was next.”

Direction called to Cavin from an available storefront on West Market Street near the Chester County Justice Center construction site. “I knew the area had the potential to be the next hot spot in West Chester,” recalls Cavin. “I enlisted Jeff Schneider, a friend with retail experience, to make The 5 Senses a viable source for shoppers who appreciate fine crafts and want to support American artists. I could never have opened without him.”

The 5 Senses has been a destination for original art and fine craft since 2005. Window displays invite all into bright nooks spilling over with fun and fancy. “I'm all about being bold and colorful. There are no paintings, only handmade works by over 90 artisans from the United States and Canada that are affordable and mostly functional. We have 20 artists

from Pennsylvania including four Chester County jewelers. We're always interested in new artists; buying local is important.”

Don't expect to breeze through Cavin's ever-changing collections. Beguiling the senses is the point. Wind chimes patterned in tiny petals of pigment or forged from reper-
